We have recently seen the quarter 3 MORI GP Patient Survey results published and find that patient access to the surgery via the telephone is, yet again, not as good as we would like it to be. (Results can be found on our website under latest news) In view of this we are going to implement an online booking service whereby you will be able to access the surgery appointments system via the internet. The current facility to access repeat prescriptions via the internet will also be upgraded at the same time.

We are doing this so that those patients who are able to book their GP appointment in advance will be able to do so on-line up to two weeks before the date they would like to come in. As 93% of those patients who responded to the MORI survey said they currently book their appointments by phone we hope that a new service such as this will provide greater access.
